There is an ongoing shortage of **Bicillin® L-A** and providers are restricted to ordering Bicillin® L-A or Lentocillin S **based on immediate need** for individuals who meet the eligibility as per the [Public Health Agency of Canada \(PHAC\) Interim Syphilis Treatment Guidelines](#). Oral doxycycline is the preferred alternative treatment for non-pregnant adults with infectious syphilis.

Lentocillin S (Benzathine Benzylpenicillin Tetrahydrate), 1.2 Million I.U. *	1 box contains: ❖ 1 vial Benzathine Benzylpenicillin Tetrahydrate 1.2 Million I.U. ❖ 1 ampoule 4ml Lidocaine 1.5% solution	2 Boxes = 1 dose (2.4 Million I.U. dose)		*only order as needed for active patient treatment
Bicillin L-A (Penicillin G Benzathine), 1.2 Million I.U. *		2 Syringes = 1 dose (2.4 Million I.U. dose)		*only order as needed for active patient treatment
*Include: 4 weeks of refrigerator temperatures with Bicillin order. Bicillin must be stored between 2° to 8° C. For Bicillin pick up orders, you must arrive with a cooler, ice packs and a thermometer. Internal cooler temperature to be kept between 2° to 8° C during transport.			▶▶▶	Attached
