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## INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

*To Rose Caterini, City Clerk, Hamilton*

We have audited the accompanying statement of campaign income and expenses and calculation of surplus or deficit of Matthew Green, candidate, for the campaign period from January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014 relating to the election held on October 27, 2014. The financial information has been prepared by the candidate in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

### *Candidate's Responsibility for the Financial Information*

The candidate is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial information in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, and for such internal control as the candidate determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the financial information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### *Auditor's Responsibility*

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial information based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial information is free of material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial information. The procedures selected depend on the auditors' judgement, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial information, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditors consider internal control relevant to the candidate's preparation and fair presentation of the financial information in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the candidate's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the candidate, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial information.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

*Basis for Qualified Opinion*

Due to the nature of the types of transactions inherent in an election campaign, it is impracticable through auditing procedures to determine that the accounting records include all donations of goods and services, and receipts and disbursements. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to ensuring that the financial information reflects the amounts recorded in the accounting records of the candidate and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to campaign income and expenses and surplus or deficit.

*Qualified Opinion*

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the statement of campaign income and expenses for the campaign period from January 2, 2014 to December 31, 2014 and the calculation of surplus or deficit present fairly, in all material respects, the financial performance of Matthew Green, candidate, in accordance with the accounting treatment prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act, 1996.

*Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution*

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to the basis of accounting, the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 does not require us to report, nor was it practical for us to determine, that contributions reported include only those which may be properly retained in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. This financial information, which has not been, and was not intended to be, prepared in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principals is solely for the information and use of Rose Caterini, City Clerk, Hamilton, for complying with the Municipal Elections Act, 1996. This financial information is not intended to be, and should not be, used by anyone other than the specified user or for any other purpose.




