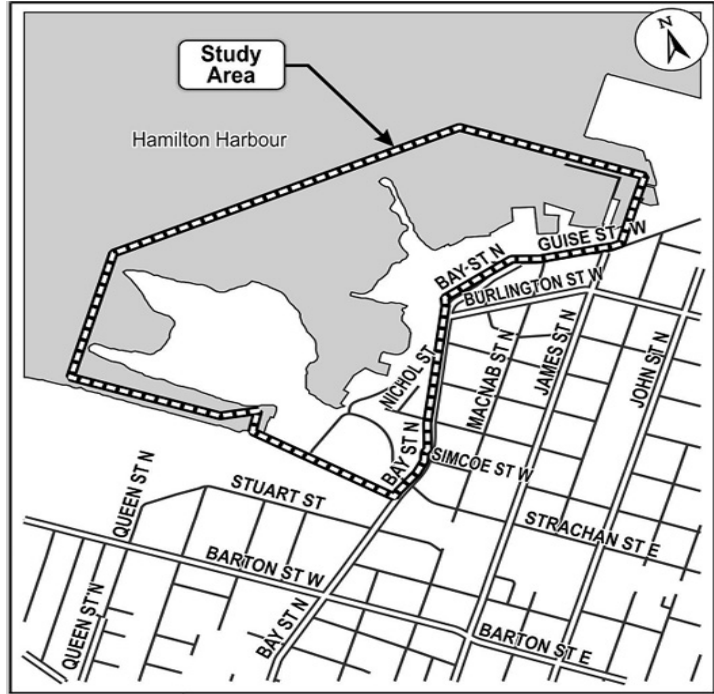
## NOTICE OF COMPLETION HAMILTON WEST HARBOUR WATERFRONT SHORELINE AND BREAKWATER INFRASTRUCTURE ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT

### THE STUDY

The City of Hamilton has completed an Environmental Study Report (ESR) to address Shoreline Improvements and Breakwater Improvements in the West Harbour. Through consultation and evaluation of alternatives, the following has been recommended:

- Replace the existing floating breakwater with a new, larger floating breakwater to improve protection from waves in the main basin.
- Repair the existing shoreline where required to address deterioration or reduce the risk of flooding or wave damage.
- Replace the existing shoreline structures in some areas where the structures are beyond repair.





The study was carried out to meet the requirements of the Municipal Engineers Association's (MEA's) Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process.



### PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD

An Environmental Study Report (ESR) describing the planning process followed and the conclusions has been prepared. A hard copy of the ESR will be placed on the public record for a 30 day review in accordance with the Municipal Class EA. **The 30-day "Review Period" will begin on May 3, 2013, and will end on June 2, 2013.** Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and receipt of necessary approvals, the City of Hamilton intends to proceed with shoreline protection and the construction of a floating breakwater.

2. Arrange a meeting with the above if you have significant concerns that may require more detailed explanation.
3. If you raise major concerns, the City will attempt to negotiate a resolution of the issues. A mutually acceptable time period for this negotiation will be set. If the issues remain unresolved, you may request the Minister of the Environment, by order, to require the City to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act before proceeding with the project.
