PIERS 5 – 8, SEWAGE PUMPING FACILITIES

The Study:

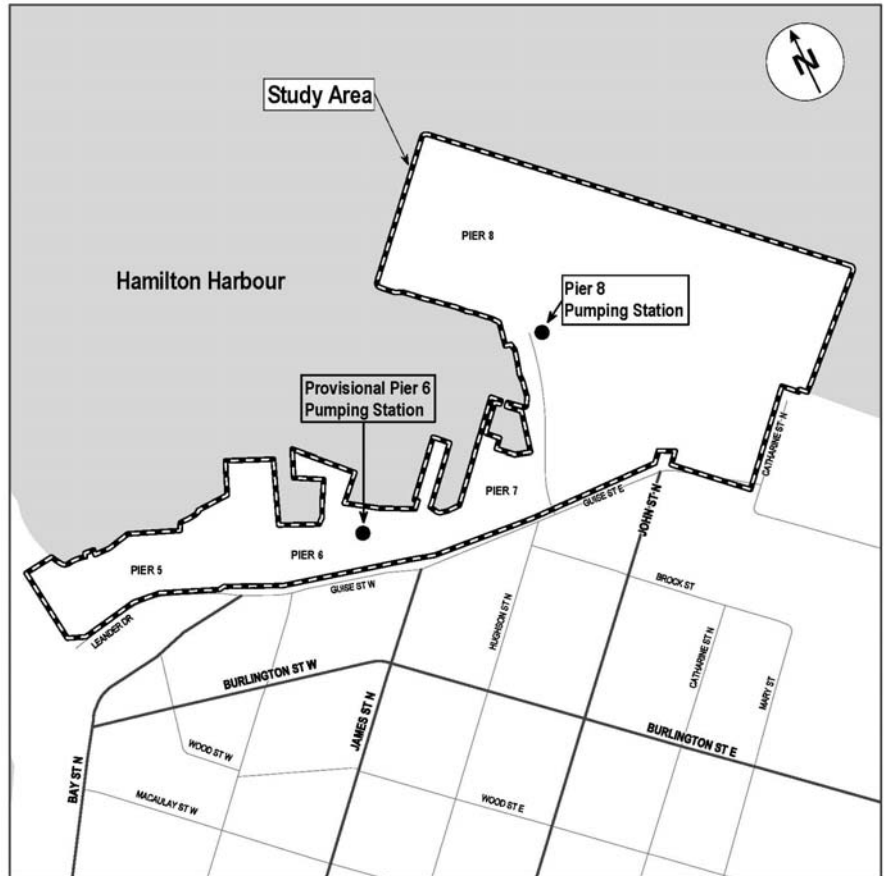
The City of Hamilton has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to review alternatives to ensure reliable wastewater service for the existing uses and future development of Piers 5 to 8, and to evaluate alternative methods to upgrading the existing Pier 8 Sewage Pumping Station.

The following solutions are recommended:

- a new Sewage Pumping Station on Pier 8 and sewer storage infrastructure: and,
- a provisional Sewage Pumping Station on Pier 6.

Opportunities for Review:

The study was carried out following the requirements for Schedule 'B' projects under the Municipal Class EA process. A Project File has been completed and placed on public record for a 30 day review period starting May 23rd, 2014 and ending June 23rd, 2014, at the following locations:
