Part of MacNab Street to be converted to two-way traffic

HAMILTON, ON – May 30, 2013 – Effective Tuesday, June 18 the portion of MacNab Street between Cannon and Burlington Streets will be permanently converted to two-way traffic. This implementation project was originally identified in both the 2001 Downtown Transportation Master Plan and the more recently completed North End Traffic Management Plan.

The conversion will require the addition of traffic signal control on the south leg of the Cannon Street and MacNab Street intersection and the installation of new stop signs at various intersections on MacNab Street North.

Staging of the conversion will commence on Monday, June 3, two-weeks prior to implementation. Motorists are advised to exercise caution while driving through this area and to be aware of new signs and pavement markings indicating the flow of traffic. Please also watch for pedestrians.
