

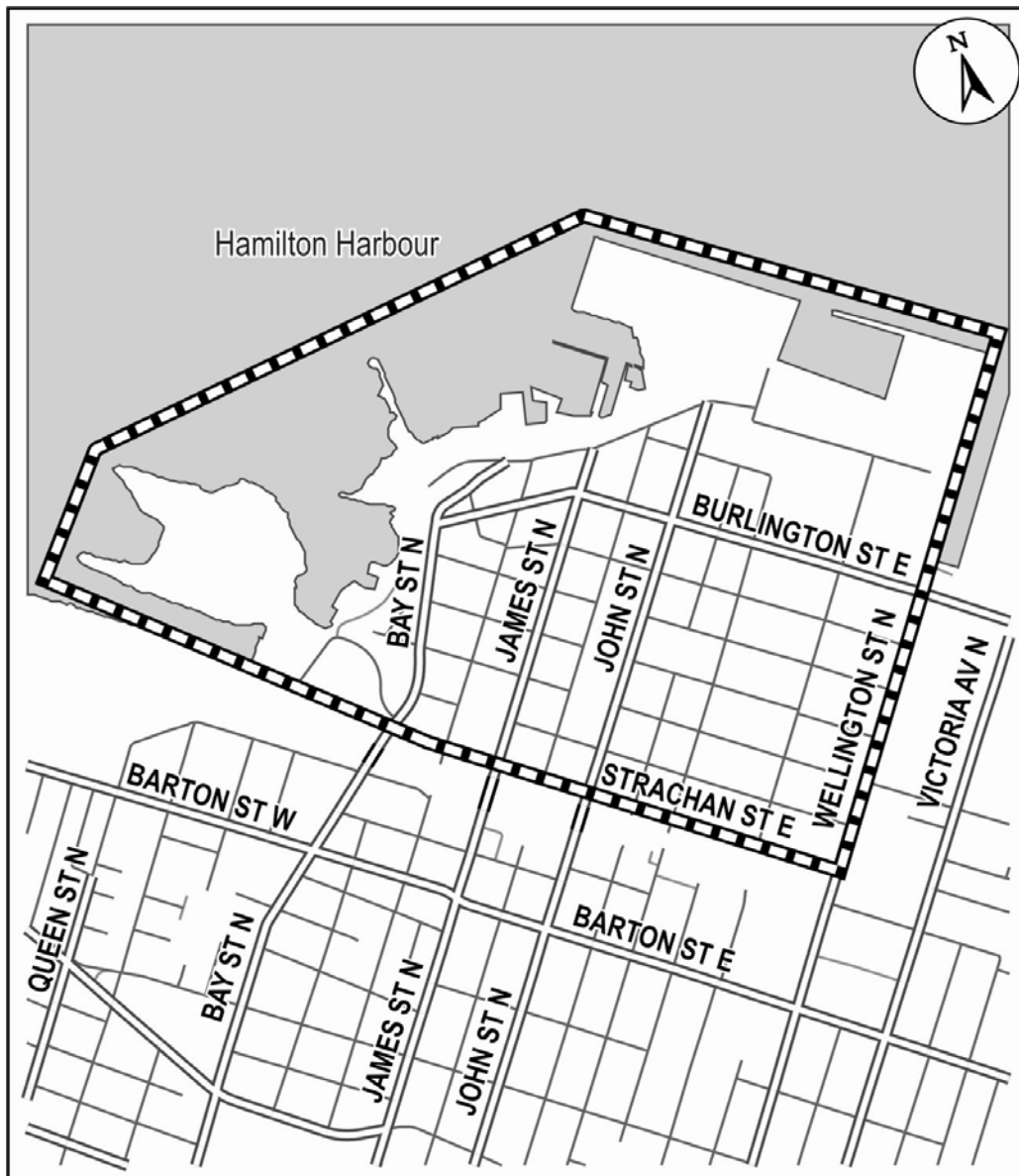


## NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE #2 NORTH END TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT STUDY CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Hamilton

### THE STUDY

The City of Hamilton has initiated the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process to develop a comprehensive Traffic Management Plan for the North End Neighbourhood (see map) that will include notably the following considerations: existing parking supply and demand; neighbourhood traffic infiltration; traffic calming opportunities; and traffic impacts associated with the redevelopment of the West Harbour.



## THE PROCESS

This project is being planned under the planning and design process for **Schedule B** projects as defined in the Municipal Engineers Association's *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (June 2000). Schedule B projects have the potential of some adverse environmental effects. These projects generally include improvements and minor expansions to existing facilities.

Upon completion of the study, a Project File Report will be available for public review and comment. Another advertisement will be published at that time.

## PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

An initial Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006 to introduce the project and receive public input on the alternatives under consideration.

A Second Public Information Centre has now been arranged to review the evaluation criteria, the existing conditions, the alternative solutions and the technically preferred alternative.

TIME: 6:00 pm – 8:00 pm.

LOCATION: Workers Arts and Heritage Centre, 51 Stuart Street, Hamilton

A third and final PIC will be held in 2007 to present the final proposed plan, based on input received.
