

**NOTICE OF FILING OF ADDENDUM  
ROPA9 Transportation Master Plan Review  
Class Environmental Assessment**

Issued: May 21, 2013

**THE STUDY**

The City of Hamilton has completed the review of the Regional Official Plan Amendment 9 (ROPA9) Transportation Master Plan (TMP) 2006 for the ROPA9 Planning and Trinity neighbourhood areas. This Master Plan Review study was initiated due to the changes in land use plans approved for the lands east of Eramosa Karst.

**THE PROCESS**

This TMP review study has been undertaken in accordance with the Municipal Engineer's Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) (October 2000, as amended in 2007 and 2011) and will satisfy Phases 1 and 2 of the planning and design process. The study reviewed existing traffic conditions, future needs, problems and opportunities and identified alternative solutions. At the conclusion of the study an addendum report documenting the planning process undertaken and the conclusions reached was prepared. The recommended projects are as follows:

1	Closure of Upper Mount Albion Road, North of Rymal Road East	a) Install temporary traffic signals at Pritchard Road & Rymal Road East. b) Asphalt overlay work on Pritchard Road, between Highland and Rymal Road c) Construct paved shoulder along west side of Pritchard Road, between trail and Stone Church Road and associated storm drainage works. d) Close Upper Mount Albion Road, north of Rymal with a cul-de-sac	A+
2	Traffic calming on Second Road West	Construct a permanent speed cushion on Second Road West, between Gatestone Drive and Fairhaven Drive	A
3	Sidewalk on Second Road West	Construct sidewalk on both sides along Second Road West Road, where required to make it continuous	A+
4	Provide bike lanes on Highland Road	Reconfigure lane markings on Highland Road to provide on-road bicycle lanes between Winterberry Drive and Upper Centennial Parkway, with the removal of existing parking at certain sections	A+
5	Sidewalk on Highland Road south side	Construct sidewalk along the south side of Highland Road, where required to make it continuous (Winterberry Drive to Upper Centennial Parkway).	A+

Only Schedule B & C projects can be appealed with a "Part II Order". There is no opportunity to put in a "Part II Order" for Schedule A and A+ projects.
