



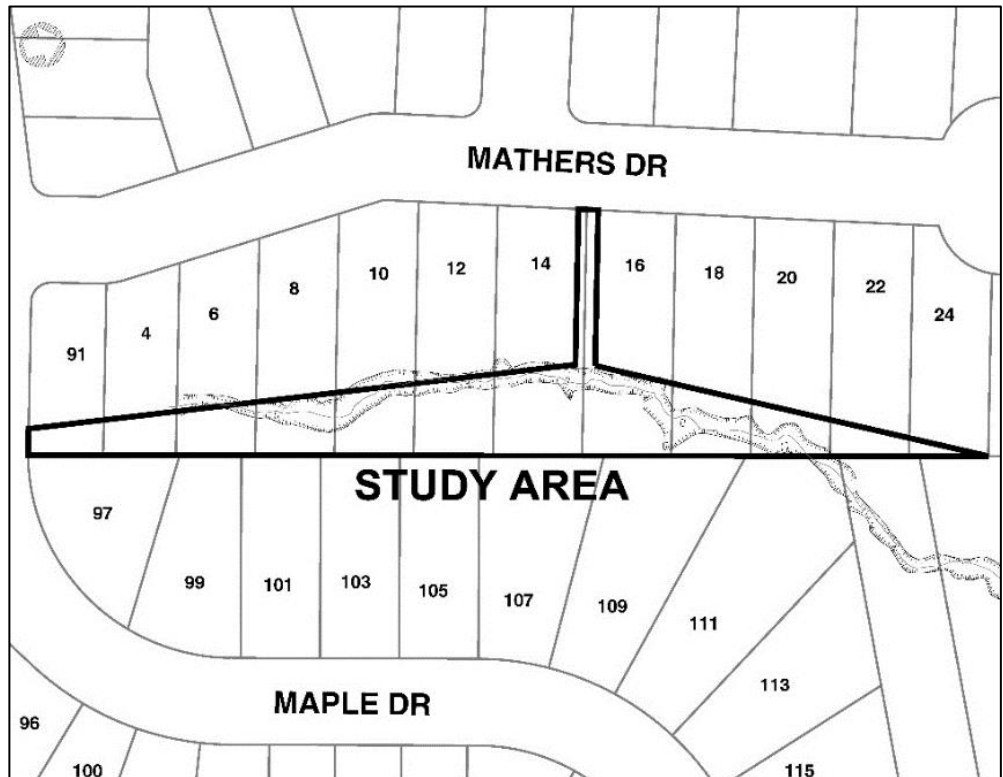
**NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

**Mathers Drive Stream & Valley Wall Erosion
Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment Study**

The City of Hamilton has completed a Schedule 'B' Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to determine the preferred alternative to protect homes in the community from erosion and valley slope failure as a result of deteriorated erosion control structures. The study was completed in accordance with Schedule B of the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Manual (MCEA, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015).

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD

A Project File Report (PFR), documenting the study process of the Class EA has been prepared and is available for 30 day public and agency review. The review and commenting period is from October 26, 2017 to November 24, 2017, during regular business hours of 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM.
