



Notice of Study Completion

Upper Hannon Creek Master Drainage Plan Class Environmental Assessment

The City of Hamilton has completed a Master Drainage Study of the Upper Hannon Creek Subwatershed. This study has been planned in accordance with Approach #2 of the Master Planning process under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Municipal Engineers Association, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015) (EA). The purpose of this Master Drainage Plan is to develop a management strategy of the stormwater resources in the area to support ongoing servicing and land use initiatives.

The recommended projects are as follows:

Trinity Church Road Trunk Storm Sewer From approximately 350 metres south of Rymal Road East (approximately 600 metres in length)	Schedule A+	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can be implemented as part of road improvements • Assumes all works in existing right-of-way and trenchless water crossings (if required)

Only Schedule B & C projects can be appealed with a “Part II Order”. There is no opportunity to issue a “Part II Order” for Schedule A and A+ projects.

Public Review Period: The Class EA Project File Report documenting the planning process undertaken and conclusions reached will be placed on public record for 30 days. **The public review period will begin on November 17, 2017 and end on December 18, 2017.**

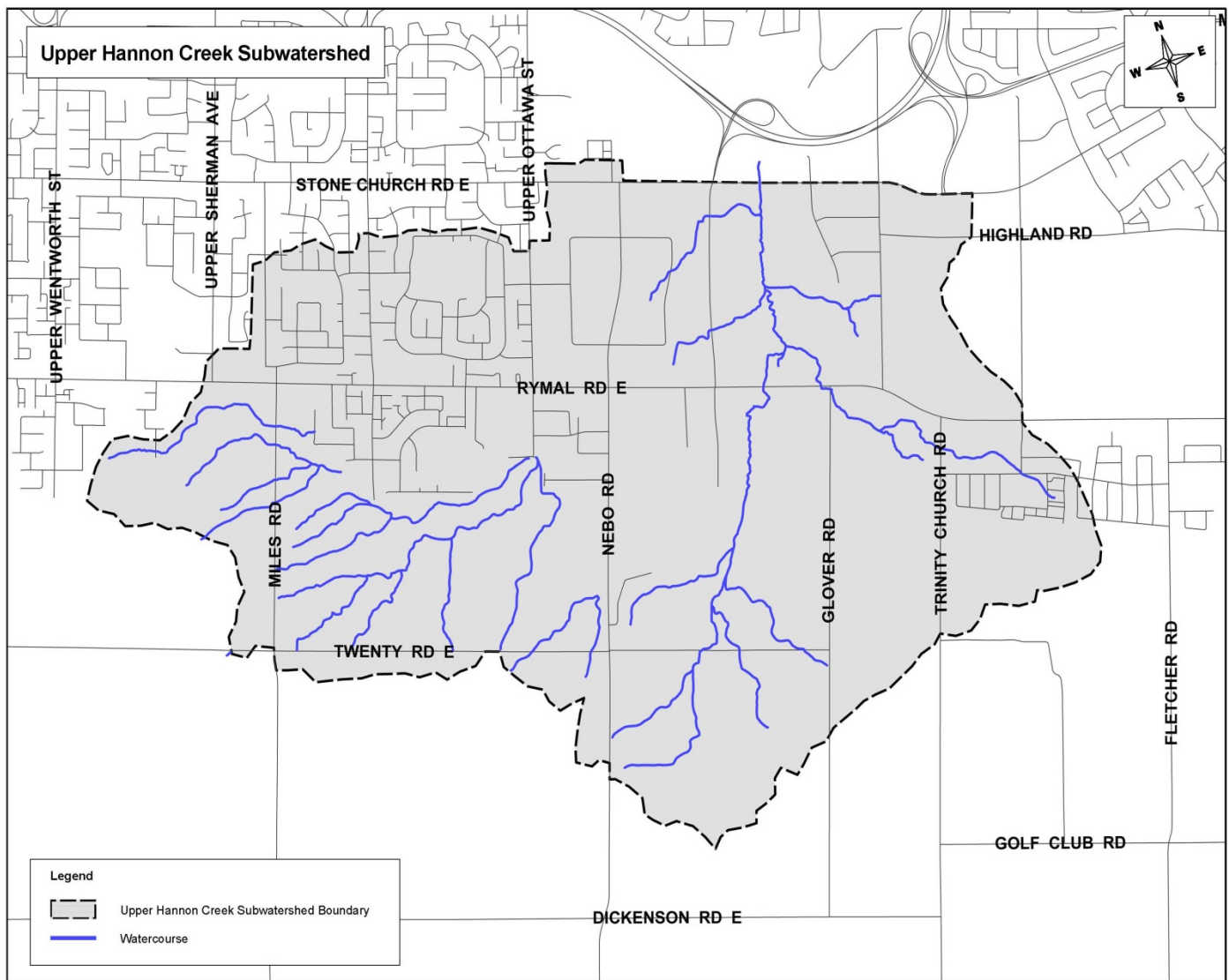
