6)	Remove Baseball Diamonds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove both baseball diamonds.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Confirmed usage and demand with Recreation staff.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The City will proceed with removing one of the baseball diamonds and replacing the second baseball diamond with a slo-pitch Softball Diamond for Youth. The Stoney Creek Little League still books the facilities and demand continues.</li> </ul>
7)	Historic Plaque	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enlarge existing historic plaque or make another larger one.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Contacted Hamilton Historical Board.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The City will implement the "Aviation Concept" which has interpretive elements in the design that are complimentary to the plaque, for example the run-way lines. A new plaque will not be installed.</li> </ul>

10)	Skate Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Would like to see a skateboard area for teens and children</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Notified Recreation staff of the request.</li> <li>• Reviewed the Skateboard Park Study (2017) and confirmed Roxborough Park was not identified as a potential site. Gage Park is the closest identified site and Sam Mason Park, although Sam Mason Park is on the other side of the Red Hill Valley Parkway.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A skateboard park is not planned for Roxborough and can not be implemented as part of this design due to budget constraints and lack of public consultation on the endeavor.</li> </ul> <p>There will be new skate parks being implemented every couple of years as per the recommendations identified in the Skateboard Park Study (2017) and Gage Park is #9 on the priority list. Recreation staff will record the request however for tracking purposes.</p>
