CITY OF HAMILTON

BY-LAW NO. 04-183

To Appoint a Tax Collector

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act* 2001, provides for an Office of the Treasurer of the City, which officer is empowered to exercise the authority vested in the tax collector under that Act;


AND WHEREAS clause 28(o) of the *Interpretation Act* provides that any words in an Act authorizing the appointment of a public officer or functionary, or the appointment of a person to administer an Act include the power of appointing a deputy to perform and have all the powers and authority of that public officer, functionary or person, which may be exercised in such manner and upon such occasions, as are specified in the instrument appointing him or her or such limited powers and authority, as the instrument prescribes;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the City to appoint Deputy Tax Collectors, to ensure that all administrative duties associated with this function may be exercised at all times;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. The appointment of Joseph L. Rinaldo, General Manager, Finance & Corporate Services, as the Treasurer and Tax Collector for the City is hereby confirmed and continued at the pleasure of Council.
2. Larry Friday hereby be appointed as Deputy Tax Collector and in that capacity may perform all duties and exercise all discretion conferred upon the Tax Collector by any By-Law of the City or Act of Province, (except where inconsistent with any Act of the Province), and for that purpose each of these shall be deemed while acting in that capacity to be a deputy treasurer of the City.
3. Larry Friday shall hold the positions described in Section 2 at the pleasure of Council.
4. By-law 01-005 is hereby repealed.
5. This By-law shall come into force and take effect as of January 1, 2004
