CITY OF HAMILTON

BY-LAW NO. 05- 018

**To Amend Bylaw No. 01-215
Being a Bylaw To Regulate Traffic**

WHEREAS Section 11(1)1 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating parking and traffic on highways subject to the Highway Traffic Act;

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 2 (Speed Limits) of By-law No. 01-215, as amended, is hereby further amended by deleting from Subsection "2" of Section "G" thereof the following item, namely:

"Hwy 52	Hwy 2	Governor's Road	80"
---------	-------	-----------------	-----

and by adding to Subsection "2" of Section "G" thereof the following items, namely:

"Highway 52	Wilson Street	400m south of Governor's 70 Road	
-------------	---------------	----------------------------------	--

Highway 52	400m south of Governor's Road	Governor's Road	60"
------------	-------------------------------	-----------------	-----

and by deleting from Subsection "4" of Section "G" thereof the following item, namely:

"Hwy 52	Governors Road	Hwy 8 (Peters Corners)	80"
---------	----------------	---------------------------	-----

and by adding to Subsection "4" of Section "G" thereof the following items,
namely:

"Highway 52 Governor's Road 580m north of Governor's 60
Road

Highway 52 580m north of Governor's King's Highway No. 8 70"
Road

- 2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-215, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.
- 3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
