**CITY OF HAMILTON
BY-LAW NO. 05-281
BEING A BY-LAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE AND SELL PART OF THE
ORIGINAL ROAD ALLOWANCE BETWEEN BROKEN LOTS 7 AND 8,
CONCESSION 8 IN THE GEOGRAPHIC TOWNSHIP OF EAST FLAMBOROUGH,
DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 62R-17171, TOWN OF FLAMBOROUGH, NOW
CITY OF HAMILTON**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* as amended, to permanently close any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton on January 26, 2005, in adopting Item 1 of the Public Works, Infrastructure and Environment Committee Report 05-002, authorized the City to permanently close and sell part of the original road allowance between Lots 7 and 8, Concession 8 in the geographic Township of East Flamborough, designated as Part 1 on Plan 62R-17171, Town of Flamborough, now City of Hamilton.

AND WHEREAS the road is a highway under the jurisdiction of the City of Hamilton;

AND WHEREAS notice of the City's intention to pass this By-law has been published pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25* as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the part of the unopened road allowance, set out as:

Part of the Original Road Allowance between Lots 7 and 8, Concession 8, in the geographic Township of East Flamborough, designated as Part 1 on Plan 62R-17171, Town of Flamborough, now City of Hamilton

is hereby permanently closed.

2. That the soil and freehold of Part 1 on Plan 62R-17171, hereby permanently closed, be sold to The Board of Trustees of Carlisle United Church for the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Wentworth (No. 62).
