BY-LAW NO. 11-074

**TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 10-053
GOVERNING THE PROCEEDINGS OF COUNCIL
AND COMMITTEES OF COUNCIL**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted by-law 10-053 being a By-law to Govern the Proceedings of Council and Committees of Council, on March 10, 2010, pursuant to section 238, of the Municipal Act, 2001,

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton, in adopting item 6 of Report 11-002 of the Emergency and Community Services Committee at its meeting held on the 17th day of February, 2011, recommended that Procedural By-law 10-053 be amended as hereinafter provided;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That item (3) of Section 5.3 regarding Standing Committee Meetings be deleted and replaced as follows:
 - (3) The Emergency & Community Services Committee shall be comprised of a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 8 members of Council and the Audit, Finance & Administration Committee shall be comprised of a minimum of 5 and maximum of 7 members of Council.
2. That Appendix E - Emergency & Community Services Committee be amended to increase the membership from a maximum of 7 members of Council to a maximum of 8 members of Council.

- 3 In all other respects By-law 10-053 remains unchanged.
4. This By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
