## **CITY OF HAMILTON**

### **BY-LAW NO. 11-104**

#### **A By-law to Amend the Water and Wastewater Fees and Charges By-law No. 11-035**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, sections 9 and 10 of the said Act authorize a municipality to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of the municipality and for the use of the municipality's property, including property under its control;

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Hamilton wishes to establish and maintain in one by-law a list of all of its water and wastewater services and activities and the use of which properties will be subject to fees or charges, as well as the amount of each fee or charge;

**AND WHEREAS** on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2011, the Council of the City of Hamilton did approve of Item 11 of Audit, Finance and Administration Committee Report 11-004 and did authorize and approve of the imposition of the additional water and wastewater fee and charge set out herein;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of the water and wastewater fee and charge set out herein has been given in accordance with the provisions of the City of Hamilton's Public Notice Policy By-law No. 07-351.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:


1. Schedule "A" to Water and Wastewater Fees and Charges By-law No. 11-035 is amended by adding the following subsection E):

- E) **VACANT PREMISES (as defined in By-law No. R84-026)**  
The Minimum Charge in A) above shall be imposed during the time that  
the water is shut off to a vacant premises.

2. This By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
