**CITY OF HAMILTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 11-231**

**To Repeal Regional Municipality of Hamilton-Wentworth By-law No. R79-202, being a  
by-law to regulate the hours of closing of retail shops**

**WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton resolved at its meeting on September 14, 2011 to repeal Regional Municipality of Hamilton-Wentworth By-law No. R79-202, being a by-law to regulate the hours of closing of retail shops;

**AND WHEREAS** the *City of Hamilton Act, 1999* did incorporate, as of January 1, 2001, the municipality "City of Hamilton";

**AND WHEREAS** the City of Hamilton is successor to the former Regional Municipality of Hamilton-Wentworth;

**AND WHEREAS** the *City of Hamilton Act, 1999* provides that the by-laws of the former Regional Municipality of Hamilton-Wentworth remain in force until they expire or are repealed or amended to provide otherwise;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

Regional Municipality of Hamilton-Wentworth By-law No. R79-202, being a by-law to regulate the hours of closing of retail shops, as amended, is repealed.
