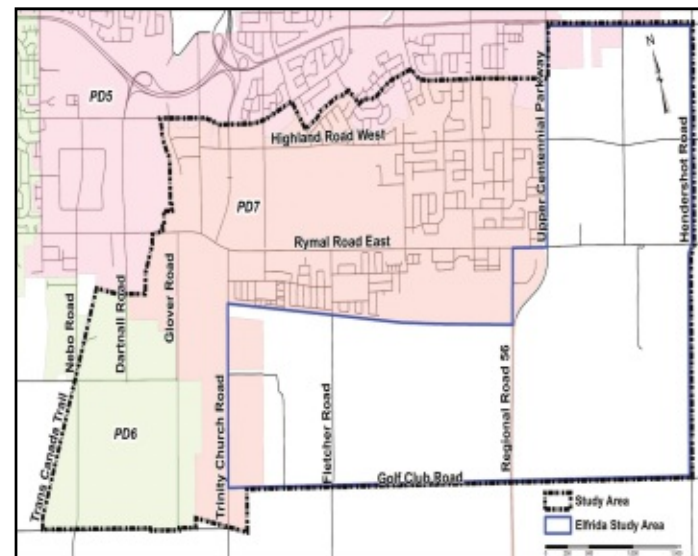


NOTICE OF COMPLETION ELEVATED WATER STORAGE FACILITY & PUMPING STATION FOR PD 7 CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY

THE STUDY

The City of Hamilton has completed the Elevated Water Storage Facility and Pumping Station for Pressure District (PD) 7 Class Environmental Assessment to determine the preferred location for constructing an elevated water storage facility and a new pumping station within the study area (see Figure below). Consultation with the public and government review agencies was carried out by issuing correspondences and holding two Public Information Centres. The study was conducted in accordance with the requirements for Schedule "B" projects as described in the Municipal Engineers Association's *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (as amended in 2007, 2011 & 2015).

Through the study, it is determined that the preferred location for an Elevated Water Storage Facility is EWSF #3 at 420 Trinity Church Road, Hannon. The primary advantages for this location include: it is not near any environmentally sensitive areas; it has no archaeological potential; it is City owned and has low construction impact; it has a reduced tank height and cost; and it is most preferred hydraulically due to high elevation and close to existing watermain. The preferred location for a new Pumping Station is PS Site 1 - Lot 24, Con. 8, Saltfleet Township at the northeast corner of Reginal Road 20 and Upper Centennial Parkway, Stoney Creek. The primary advantages for this location include: it has no negative impacts to cultural heritage resources; it has medium construction impact due to near residential area; it is City owned, with the ability to coordinate with planned infrastructure improvements; it is most preferred hydraulically and has the highest pressure in PD7.



PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD
