BY-LAW NO. 13-164

Respecting

Removal of Part Lot Control Block 312, Registered Plan No. 62M-1158 and Block 171, Plan 62M-1159

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating lots for single detached dwellings, shown as Parts 1-8 inclusive, and more particularly shown as Parts 4 and 5, Parts 3 and 6, Parts 2 and 7 and Parts 1 and 8, inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-19517, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

> Block 312, Registered Plan No. 62M-1158, and Block 171, Registered Plan No. 62M-1159 in the City of Hamilton

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 22 day of May, 3. 2015.
