CITY OF HAMILTON

BY-LAW NO. 14-017

Being a By-law to Permanently Close a Portion of Waterberry Trail, being Block 6 on Plan 62M-1077, City of Hamilton.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under Sections 10(2) and 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, to permanently close any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS by execution of a subdivision agreement dated February 28, 2006, the City of Hamilton has authorized and agreed to the closure and conveyance of a certain portion of Waterberry trail, being Block 6 on Plan 62M-1077, when deemed by the City to no longer be required for road purposes.

AND WHEREAS the road is a highway under the jurisdiction of the City of Hamilton;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That part of the road allowance, being Waterberry Trail in the City of Hamilton described as Block 6 on Plan 62M-1077, City of Hamilton, is, hereby permanently closed.
2. The soil and freehold of Block 6 on Plan 62M-1077; City of Hamilton, hereby permanently closed, be transferred to Armour Steel Supply Limited for nominal consideration pursuant to the terms of the subdivision agreement registered as Instrument No. WE 442463.
3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Wentworth (No. 62).
