Terms and Conditions

1. This permit is issued in accordance with Section 110 of the HTA for the movement of a load, object, structure or vehicle that cannot be reasonably divided. It may however be used in conjunction with, and in strict accordance to, a Special Vehicle Configuration Permit issued by the Ministry of Transportation for the movement of finished steel products.
2. Annual Overload Permits used in conjunction a Special Vehicle Configuration Permit issued by the Ministry of Transportation as outlined in 1) are confined to travel on City of Hamilton Truck Routes with the exception of municipal roads that cross bridge structures over any King's Highway which is prohibited. Travel on any King's Highway is also prohibited.

3. Annual Overload Permits are valid for a vehicle and load that are within the following dimensions. A vehicle and/or load that exceed these dimensions will require a single trip permit:

2.6m to 3.85m/8ft 6in to 12ft 7in. wide and/or,

23m to 25m/75ft 6in to 82ft long and/or,

4.15m to 4.26m/13ft 7in to 13ft 11in. high

4. An original, signed, Certificate of Insurance must be attached to show evidence of current Commercial General Liability insurance in the name of the applicant with a minimum of \$2,000,000 per occurrence and endorsed to include the **City of Hamilton as additional insured**, and current Standard Form Automobile Liability Insurance in the name of the applicant with a minimum limit of \$5,000,000 per occurrence. (Please note that automobile liability slips are not valid proof of insurance). It is the applicants responsibility to provide valid dated insurance. The City will not be held liable should an updated certificate not be provided.
5. The permit holder and driver are responsible for compliance with the Highway Traffic Act, and its regulations, and other laws in respect of the vehicle and load. This permit is not authorization to contravene such laws, and in particular any over dimensional and/or over-weight load and vehicle must be divided if reasonable, in accordance with subsection 110(1) of the Highway Traffic Act.
6. This permit is not valid at any time when, due to insufficient light, or unfavourable atmosphere conditions, persons and vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of 150 metres or less.
7. The original of this permit must be carried in the vehicle and produced upon demand of a police officer or an officer appointed for carrying out the provisions of the Ontario Highway Traffic Act or a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer.

Revocation

8. The City of Hamilton reserves the right to cancel this permit upon 30 days notice at any time.
9. This permit may be permanently revoked if:
- (i) any vehicle in the combination has an out of service defect;
 - (ii) there is any weight or dimension violation;
 - (iii) there is any breach of any condition of this permit;
 - (iv) there is any deviation from the City of Hamilton Truck Route;
 - (v) the holder of this permit is found to have an unacceptable CVOR safety record.
 - (vi) the holder fails to maintain insurance as shown above under section 4

Declaration

I/we understand that under the provision of subsection 5 of Section 110 of the Ontario Highway Traffic Act, the owner, operator or mover of a heavy vehicle, load, object or structure who has obtained a permit is nevertheless responsible for all damages that may be caused to the highway, encroachments or railway right-of-way by reason of the driving, operating or moving of any such heavy vehicle, load, object or structure.

The applicant certifies that the information contained in this application is true and acknowledges and accepts the responsibilities imposed by law, in particular the Highway Traffic Act, as applicable to the applicant, in relation to the operation of a commercial motor vehicle under the authority of the permit issued pursuant to this application. Permits are invalid if false information is given.
