The purpose of this Information Update is to advise Council that as of January 1, 2021, the City of Hamilton will transition to a newly appointed Contracted Parking Enforcement Vendor for the Downtown Core and BIA areas.

The Canadian Corps of Commissionaires (Corps) has been the long-standing contracted vendor for the City of Hamilton for several decades. The terms and expiration of the current contract with the Corps ends on Dec 31, 2020.

Prior to the expiration of the current contract, an open procurement process for contracted enforcement services was initiated. That process came to completion in Q4 of 2020 and resulted in the contract being awarded to Imperial Parking Canadian Corporation (IMPARK). IMPARK, part of the REEF Parking Network, has over 15,000 members of staff currently located in 500 North American cities. With existing operations already within Hamilton and surrounding area, IMPARK is well positioned to provide contracted parking enforcement services.

Staff are appreciative of the long-standing services provided by the Corps and their cooperation through the transition to the new contactor.
