

COVID-19 VACCINE ROLLOUT ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Canada | Federal

- Approve vaccines for use in Canada
- Procure vaccines nationally
- Distribute vaccines to Provinces/Territories
- Provide National Advisory Committee on Immunization (NACI) recommendations on prioritization of vaccine administration to Provinces/Territories
- Provide supplies in some cases

Ontario | Provincial

- Receive vaccines from Federal Government
- Prioritize vaccine rollout across Ontario, including who gets the vaccine and when through COVID-19 Vaccination Prioritization Framework
- Distribute vaccines to public health units, primary care settings, pharmacies and local hospitals
- Responsible for vaccine tracking, data and health-care records management through COVaxON
- Provide e-portal and phonenumber for booking of vaccine appointments
- Provide supplies in some cases

Hamilton Public Health Services | Municipal

- In collaboration with the Hamilton COVID-19 Vaccine Task Force (Hamilton Public Health Services, local hospitals, primary care partnership), provide vaccination program support and administer vaccines to prioritized groups using the Provincial COVID-19 Prioritization Framework and sequencing
- Vaccine supply management, storage and distribution
- Liaison role with Provincial Ministry of Health
- Liaison role between Ontario Health and long-term care homes, retirement homes, congregate living settings, local hospitals, pharmacies, primary care settings
- Oversight and leadership in the implementation of all immunization clinics and modalities to administer COVID-19 vaccines to priority groups under the provincial vaccine plan (March 2021)
- Oversight of local data from COVaxON
- Oversight of local communications (social media, media relations, web content and public engagement)

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
