To Subscribers:

Re: Monthly Report for the month of March 2021

The Building Division report of building activity for March 2021 is enclosed for your perusal.

In March the Division issued \$153.36 million in building permits. There were 657 building permits and 219 zoning verification/property reports issued.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 71.35% of the month's total and is valued at \$109.43 million. Of the 453 permits in the residential category, 51 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$4.69 million. Commercial activity accounts for 6.93% or \$10.63 million with 45 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 17.13% or \$26.27 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 2.30% or \$3.52 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
