This Information Update is to inform Mayor Eisenberger and Members of Council about the asphalt repairs and maintenance that are required on the Lincoln M. Alexander Parkway (LINC).

Maintenance on the LINC will include spot repairs to the asphalt, sections of mill and pave resurfacing, catch basin cleaning, bridge repair, graffiti removal, ditching, vegetation control, pavement marking and sign repair.

Both directions of the LINC will be closed simultaneously between Thursday, May 26, 2022 and Monday, May 30, 2022, due to the nature of the work and to ensure health and safety precautions.

Eastbound Closure: Thursday, May 26, 2022 at 11:00 p.m. – Monday, May 30, 2022 at 4:00 a.m. from Golf Links Road to the Red Hill Valley Parkway (RHVP), including the RHVP off ramp from the eastbound LINC; and

Westbound Closure: Friday, May 27, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. – Monday, May 30, 2022 at 4:00 a.m. from the RHVP to Highway 403.

Detour routes will be well signed, and a robust communications plan will inform residents of the weekend traffic disruptions. Detour routes will be via Mohawk Road and Stone Church Road.

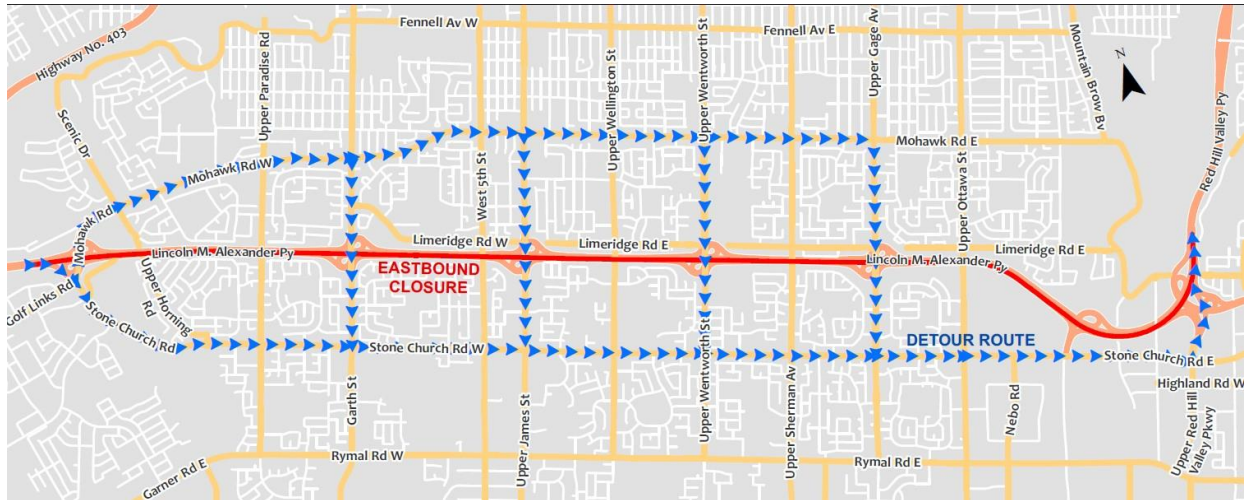

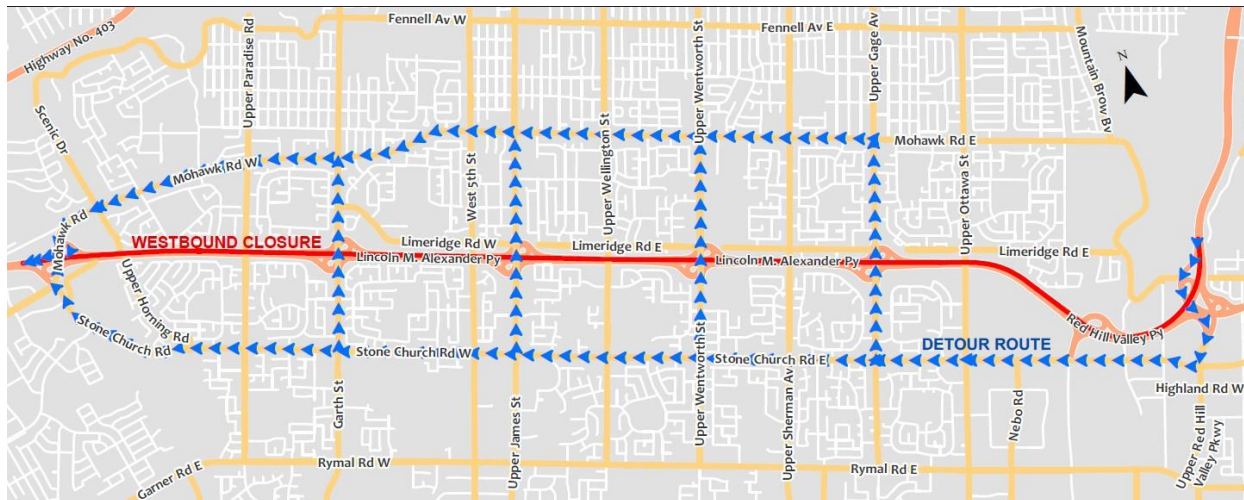
